**0 - 12 months**  
fever above 100.4

**12 months and older**  
fever above 102

## Child has 2 or more of the following:

- Increased breathing rate
- grunting, wheezing, or difficulty breathing
- no wet diaper or has not voided for 12 hours
- frequent vomiting or diarrhea
- slow to wake up
- continuous whimpering or moaning even if consoled
- complain of their throat or ears hurting
- symptoms become worse
